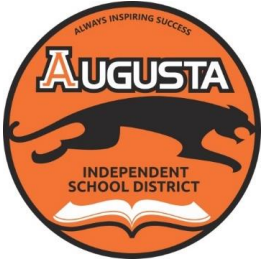

Augusta Independent will be following the recommendation of Governor Beshear by taking the necessary steps to ensure the health and well-being of our students and staff.

Beginning Monday, March 16, we will be closed and using Non-Traditional Instruction days through Friday, April 3, 2020. Thursday, March 19, Friday, March 20 and Spring Break, April 6-10 remain as school calendar days the district is closed, therefore, these days students will not have NTI assignments. The district will assist families with Chromebooks or instructional packets, as needed. More information for parents/guardians regarding NTI days will be forthcoming from teachers.

In addition, A.I.S.D. will be implementing the following:

1. All activities and athletics will be suspended until April 13. KHSAA has mandated a dead period for athletic programs until that date.
2. No students will be permitted in school facilities for any reason
3. No student field trips
4. No out of state travel for staff for Professional Learning and Development
5. Food Services: Breakfast and Lunch will be available daily. Breakfast Pick-Up 9-10 a.m./Lunch Pick-Up 12-1 p.m. at the cafeteria double-doors and meal delivery is available to families with hardships upon request. Backpack Snack Program will be available Wednesday, March 18 and future Fridays from 12-1 p.m.
6. School-based therapy will continue through Comprehend, Inc. and information forthcoming
7. The Fitness Center will be closed until April 13
8. Faculty & Staff will report daily from 8:30-3:00 p.m.
