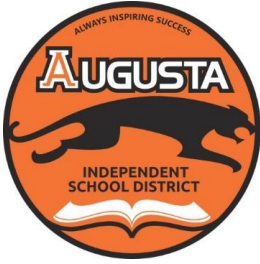

This is the new online schedule teachers will be using starting on Monday, March 30. This is an effort to make sure that all students have the opportunity to connect with all of their teachers at a scheduled time. Teachers will be online and offering instruction for each period at times listed above.

Parent, guardians and students: It is very important for you to stay in contact with your teachers and keep up with the instruction they are delivering. Since NTI will be our method of instruction for an extended period, the teachers will be introducing new concepts and do all of their instruction virtually. **For you to keep up and maximize your learning so that you do not fall behind, it is necessary for you to log on to work with your teacher during the times scheduled above.** Using your Chromebooks or another device to get online is the best way for both you and your teacher to accomplish this. The teachers will be using Zoom, Google Meet or possibly another online meeting platform to connect with you. As always if you have any questions, please reach out to your teachers.

If you do not have any access at all to the internet, you will be responsible for getting packets, completing those and getting them back to your teachers. I would advise you to reach out to your teachers by phone if you do not have the internet so that they can offer you instruction and answer any question you might have. Teachers and administrators are monitoring which students are engaged and those who are not. We have not determined exactly how grades are going to look for the 4th 9 weeks, but it will be hard to pass a class if you do not take part and keep up either online or with the packets. We understand that this makes education more challenging, but it is the best way considering all of the circumstances. The AIS faculty and staff have worked very hard to ensure that our students still have access to high quality instruction during these NTI days. More importantly, we miss

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the students and look forward to talking with them and using this as an opportunity to build stronger relationships with each of our students.
